In this season of giving, your gift will ensure we all benefit and are invested in our future.

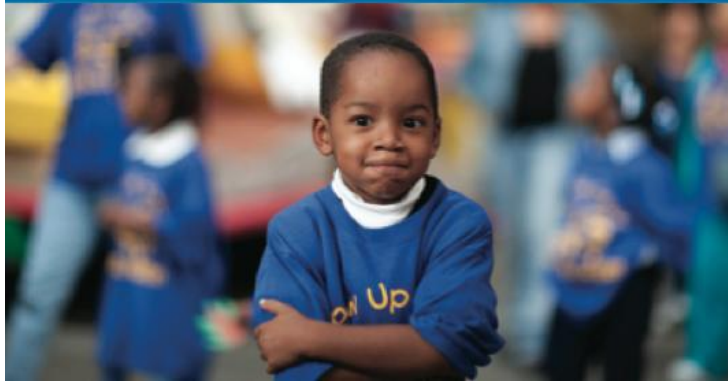
